<p><u>Academic Affairs</u></p> <p>Class Rep Meetings have been underway this week across the University, the last of the Semester.</p> <p>Hoodie / Sweater sales have been ongoing in the Meetings for Class Reps.</p>	
<p><u>Campus and Facilities</u></p> <p>City:</p> <p>A significant amount of new furniture has been settled across the City Campuses in areas like Bradogue, Lower House and Bolton Street.</p> <p>Supplier for Pool tables in BST is willing to independently invest in CCTV for the common room to crackdown on destruction.</p> <p>Blanch:</p>	

<p>Meeting about Shuttle Bus took place today, April 9th with the relevant stakeholders. An issue has occurred where a singular bus hasn't been showing up and the timetable in which the bus doesn't show up doesn't correspond with TU Dublin's real-time website information.</p> <p>It was noted in the Meeting with the ongoing construction in Blanch, it may be difficult to secure back that bus.</p> <p>The meeting discussed the Parking in Blanchardstown Motion, a motion that took concern on the clamping practises around the Campus.</p> <p>The Clamping cases are done by an external 3rd party, not the University so it is difficult to secure resolutions on the issue.</p> <p>Tallaght:</p> <p>EuT+ conference in GG has been ongoing this week.
