<u>City Campus</u>	
The VP for City Campus met with David Gavin,

Funding for the facility is secured, with the University believing the rack to be open by next Semester.	
Blanchardstown Campus	
The VP for Blanchardstown Campus met with the Students' Union's General Manager and President to discuss Blanchardstown common room facilities, and the feasibility of a foot washing room on Campus.	
Following on from earlier surveys undertaken by the CVPs, a proposal to the University re Bins on Campus has been approved for submission.	
Tallaght Campus
