Events and Engagement: This is my Constitutional mandate. Therefore, I will approach it with zeal and vigour because I think this aspect of campus life would be valuable, improving the number of events on or near the Tallaght campus. As well as possibly hosting more alcohol-free events or earlier starting events. I believe these factors can encourage people to engage with the college community more, helping people to feel more included. Free gym time for students: With the new gym facility in operation, I will build on the conversation to have more free gym access hours for students.

Medical Access for part-time students: This is a small group of students, but they continue to struggle with accessing the service; thus, I will seek to lobby the health services and Student Services to allow them access to this free service on campus to enhance the student experience.

A shade for bike parking: Working closely with the Sustainability team and PTO to have more shaded areas for students to park their bikes. This way, we encourage more students to use this less harmful means of transport, helping us contribute towards reducing carbon footprints.
