Items for Discussion

Student Levy

The University has proposed the implementation of a student levy.

The proposal outlines a range of capital projects for which the levy will cover, notably with a Student Centre as a fourth priority.

The President believes that a Student Centre should be higher on the list.

The Campus VP for City Campus proposed that the Executive should create their own proposal reprioritizing the order of investment.

Understanding that the Students' Union's response will have to be taken from a "give and take" approach, the CVP elaborated that if the Union wants the Student Centre as number one, that they must also keep the development of a Sports Centre in the Top 3 to leverage their position.

On the question as to how much per annum the levy will be on students, the President iterated that they don't have that information as it stands.

They believed that the levy will have to be founded on a commitment from the University, whether the levy will rise in future ordinarily or through inflation and that the Students' Union must consider the governance of the
